City to Host Community Workshop on Land Use, Transportation, and Safety

OJAI, CA (June 26, 2022) Please join Ojai neighbors and community stakeholders on Tuesday, August 2, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., for an in-person and virtual General Plan workshop at the newly renovated Kent Hall, 111 Santa Ana St., next to City Hall.

Building on the community vision, the group will consider options for the land use, transportation, and safety policy direction of the General Plan.

A general plan is a city's blueprint to manage change and preserve community character. General plans help shape and improve the quality of life for residents and businesses. Generally, cities update their general plans every 10 to 15 years.

This update to the City's General Plan, will result in a new long-range planning document that will aim to improve the quality of life for all residents, protect what is unique and special about Ojai, and address challenges of tomorrow.

This General Plan Update focuses on land use, transportation, safety, housing, and environmental justice. It also addresses other topics, such as parks and recreation, noise, conservation, and open space, as needed to ensure consistency throughout the document.
