SR-150 Reduced to One Lane Overnight in Ventura County

OJAI, MIRA MONTE — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) plans to reduce State Route 150 (SR-150) to one lane overnight with flaggers directing alternating traffic between Mira Monte and Ojai from Tuesday to Friday, Sept. 3-7, for pavement work. Signs will be posted. Motorists can expect delays.

The work is part of a paving and curb ramps improvement project that was paused because of an agreed-upon moratorium with the city of Ojai to avoid disrupting the busy summer tourist season from June to August. Paving will continue nightly for approximately four weeks from Monday to Friday. No work is scheduled on holidays or weekends, except for overnight hours that extend until 6 a.m. Saturday.

Overnight Lane Closure on SR-150

Tuesday, Sept. 3, to Friday, Sept. 6

- **8 p.m. to 6 a.m.**: Between Santa Ana Canyon Road and Gorham Road
- Work progresses in sections on SR-150.

All work is subject to change due to weather or construction-related issues. Residents and businesses located near the freeway may experience noise, vibrations and dust associated with construction activities. The closure may start or end later. The lane reopens each morning.
