RESOLUTION NO. 14-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI,
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR
LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 3 PURSUANT TO
RESOLUTION 14-03 AND DECLARING THE COUNCIL'S INTENT TO SET
THE ASSESSMENTS WITHOUT AN INCREASE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ojai, California adopted Resolution No. 14-03 dated the 28th day of January 2014, in accordance with the provisions of the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972" of the State of California, requiring the City Engineer to make and file with the City Clerk a report in writing presenting certain matters relating to the continuation of a maintenance district known as the Landscaping and Lighting District No. 3; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Report has been prepared and submitted to the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City Council declares its intention to levy and collect assessments without an increase and order certain maintenance activities and certain street lighting standards, fixtures, appliances and other public improvements to be maintained and electrical energy to be furnished for said fixtures for a period beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015 as specifically outlined on the Engineers Report.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** That said Engineer's Report is approved as prepared, or as modified by the City Council.
- Section 2.** That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Ojai to levy and collect assessments which will result in no increase in assessment within the assessment district referred to above.
- Section 3.** That said assessments, when adopted, shall be used for the maintenance and servicing of various improvements within the district, including, but not limited to: landscape and irrigation maintenance, lighting maintenance, storm drain maintenance, sidewalk, curb, gutter and related infrastructure maintenance, and the maintenance of miscellaneous facilities within the boundaries of Landscaping and Lighting District No. 3.
