**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI
SUPPORTING THE PROPOSED BOUNDARY REVISION FOR THE OJAI
BASIN GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Ojai Groundwater Management Agency is the recognized Groundwater Sustainability Agency for the Ojai Basin; and

WHEREAS, the Ojai Groundwater Management Agency is responsible for preparation and administration of a Sustainable Groundwater Management Plan for the Ojai Groundwater Basin; and

WHEREAS, The majority of land within the City limits of the City of Ojai is located within the Ojai Basin; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for proper management to more precisely and scientifically define the location of all alluvial areas that are part of the Ojai Basin groundwater storage; and

WHEREAS, the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency has undertaken the necessary research to define the appropriate limits of the Ojai Basin, as depicted in "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Ojai supports the revised map depicting the 8.72 square mile alluvial basin area that should be managed by the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency, which is depicted in "Exhibit A".

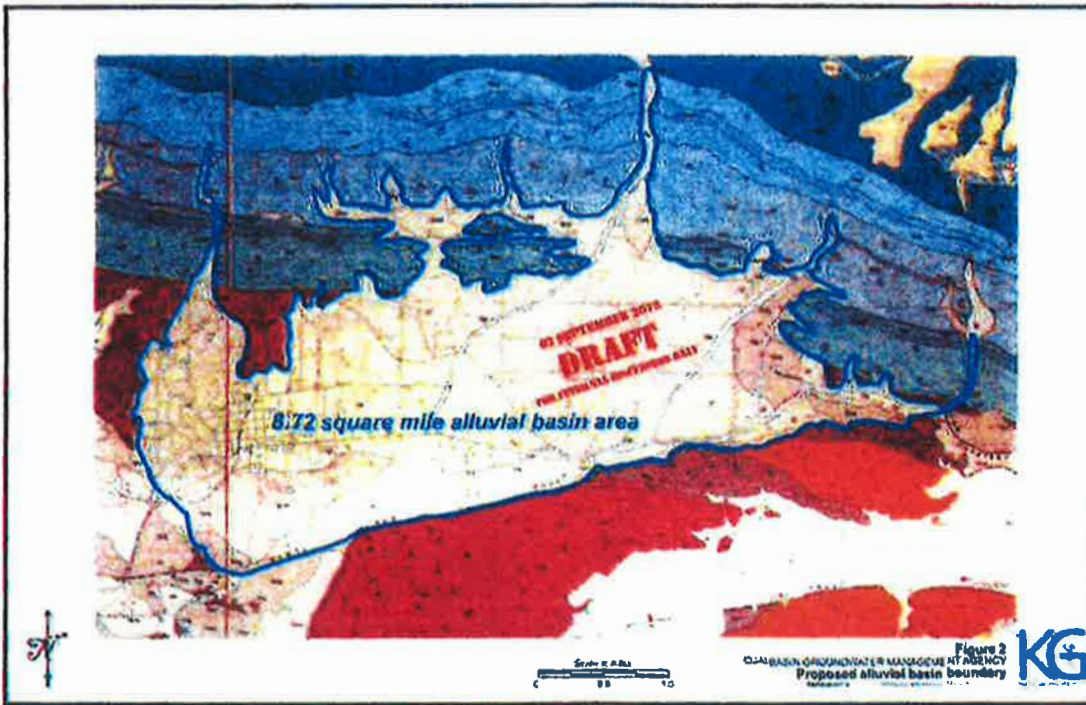
