Resolution No. 18-08**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER WITH
CREATIVE BUS SALES FOR AN THE AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$488,536 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO NEW
REPLICA TROLLEY TRANSIT VEHICLES.**

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2016, the City submitted a grant application to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5311 Grant for the purchase of up to two (2) new replica trolley transit vehicles; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2017, the State of California Department of Transportation fully executed Agreement No. 64BC17-00378 in the amount of \$291,536 under the FTA Section 5311 program for said purchase; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2016, the California Association for Coordinated Transportation and the Morongo Basin Transit Authority Purchasing Cooperative (CalACT/MBTA) awarded a contract for the CalACT/MBTA Joint Procurement No. 15-03 to Creative Bus Sales to purchase paratransit and transit vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the CalACT/MBTA Purchasing Cooperative vehicle specifications meet the requirements of the Ojai Trolley Service's desired vehicle specifications for transit service; and

WHEREAS, the CalACT/ MBTA Purchasing Cooperative has approved the assigning to the City of Ojai of two (2) of the available vehicles under said purchase contract.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI,
CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Authorizes the City Manager to execute a purchase agreement with Creative Bus Sales for the purchase of two new replica trolley vehicles for an amount not to exceed \$488,536. The Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget is hereby amended to increase appropriations out of the Local Transportation Fund (Fund 23) by \$488,536 for this purchase and to increase revenues to the Capital Improvements Funds from state and federal grants by the same amount.


